

Crackle Finish Waiver

Crackle Finishes produced by Davis Mill and Cabinet, LLC (DMC) use a special process and coating that dries with irregular “crazing” that are characteristic of old layers of cracked paint. The intent of this finish process is to create a unique “aged” look.

1. When producing a Crackle Finish, an artisan applies multiple steps of stains and glazes to create overall color and depth. By hand brushing and crackling selective areas cabinetry is artistically aged, meaning each door, drawer front, and other components will vary in the degree of the crackle pattern. The crackle on a given door sample will vary from the actual project. Parts within the project will vary from one piece to another.
2. While crackle can be somewhat controlled, the size and pattern of crackle will vary from piece to piece and from one finish to the next.
3. This is a look and feel to experience as a whole as opposed to individual pieces. Door samples are **always required** for Crackle Finishes. The door samples may or may not exhibit all possible variations within a project. These variations are to be expected and are not reason for replacement.

We call your attention to these facts because the effect of these characteristics in an entire project may be different from what you will see in viewing a small display or small finish sample.
