

Engineered Veneer Waiver

Engineered Veneers (also known as Reconstituted or Recomposed Veneers) are a man-made product using natural wood veneers. They are made from various species of common wood veneers. The veneers that are dyed multiple colors, arranged to achieve the desired effect then glued and pressed back into a large block of a repeating pattern. After the engineered block is dry, it is sliced at a cross-section to the glue layers. This produces a very uniform and repeatable veneer. Davis Mill and Cabinet has found that, If uniformity is a key goal of the design, Engineered Veneers are the best option.

Some or all of the following may apply to your project:

1. This is a strictly veneer product. No solid wood is available to match. All parts are made from veneer materials. Any design using Engineered Veneers must use Slab doors and flat molding. Square (#5 edge) or very slight radius (#6 edge) is possible if 2mm edge banding is available and used.
2. Edge banding is vertical only. No horizontal edge banding is available.
3. No “poly” material is available in Engineered Veneers. If the project is designed with finished ends, only 2 sided veneer will be used. The inside of a cabinet, that may otherwise have a melamine interior, will be Engineered Veneer also.
4. Panels are limited to 1220mm wide x 2438mm long (4’ x 8’). Panels wider or longer will require splices to achieve the desired width or length.
5. Although this is an engineered product, it still has many of the characteristics of real wood such as the possibility to warp, shrink or swell. Sunlight and age can change the color. Extremes in temperature or humidity can adversely affect the veneers.
6. Door samples are **always required** for Engineered Veneer projects (this excludes the DMC Metro Line of doors and finishes).
