

High Pressure Laminate Waiver

Some or all of the following may apply to your project:

1. High Pressure Laminate (HPL) is backed by a thin phenolic backer. This backer causes a dark line to appear on the edges of panels and cabinets. It can be visible anywhere a part is edge banded with HPL banding.
2. While HPL is a very hard surface, some finishes can scratch very easily. The higher the gloss, the more likely scratches will show.
3. If only one side of a panel is laminated, the panel is said to be “unbalanced.” Unbalanced panels will warp. To avoid this, the panels are either made 2 sided or a nondescript laminate backer is placed on the back side to balance the panel. While efforts are made to prevent warpage, some minor warpage may still occur on laminate panels.
4. Door samples are **always required** for High Pressure Laminate projects. The door sample may or may not, exhibit all possible variations that will be visible within a project.
