

Toned Finish Waiver

Toned finishes produced by Davis Mill and Cabinet, (DMC) are finishes that include a tinted or dyed spray sealer or top coat. Some or all of the following may apply to your project:

1. Because of the necessity to hand spray these types of finishes, it is very difficult to achieve even color tones from piece to piece. Toned finishes with glazes are somewhat easier because the glaze helps to give a more uniform tone.
2. Toned finishes are especially difficult on very small or very large pieces. Small pieces (such as small fillers or even larger face frames with small stiles or rails) are difficult because once color has been sprayed on all edges, the flat surfaces have already been coated with the toner several times. This causes small parts such as this to become darker than surrounding parts on the job.
3. Extra-large parts are difficult because the individual spraying the toner may not be able to reach all the way across the part. This can cause areas to be under or over toned.
4. Complex and ornate parts can also be difficult to tone evenly. The more parts on an assembly, the more angles the toner must be sprayed from. This causes overlap in spray pattern and the end result may be uneven tones.
5. Variation or unevenness is inherent in a toned finish and is therefore not grounds for warranty replacement.
